


Before you begin:


- Please take note of different standards and regulations that are dictated by your local plumbing codes. This product is certified in accordance with North American building codes.
- We insist that you use the services of a professional plumber with experience in the installation of similar fixtures.
- Ensure that the piping system is well secured to prevent rattling, vibration and banging noises caused by a water hammer. We also recommend that you use water hammer arrestors.
- Ensure that the interior of the water pipes is clean from debris, sand, solder and any other residue.
- Always remove cartridges and other valve components before welding. Purge the water supply system for around 30 seconds, and then carefully reinstall the cartridges.











Do not over tighten when closing or opening






Use a tool to remove the limiting temperature device.



Turn on water.




While measuring the water temperature, turn the control clockwise until you reach 49°C.







Replace the limiting temperature device so that it prevents the cartridge from turning further.





Maintaining Your Vogt Finish No matter which finish you select, here are a few simple steps to keep your Vogt kitchen and bath fixtures looking beautiful for years:

- Daily:wipe the fixture dry with a soft cloth after each use this is the single most important care you can give any finish!
- Occasionally: use a mild clear liquid soap with a neutral PH balance and water to gently clean your faucet. Do not use any abrasive chemicals
- When necessary: a 50/50 solution of vinegar and water can be applied to remove hard water deposits. Do not soak the product in the solution. Vinegar is a mild acid which will harm the finish with prolonged contact. Premix in squirt bottle, spray clean/rinse/wipe dry. Use a soft brush to break-up mineral deposits.
- Avoid all cleaning products that contain ammonia, bleach and alcohol. They may damage the finish. Use clear liquid soap with a neutral PH balance.

WARRANTY

VOGT offers Limited Lifetime Warranty against defects in workmanship and materials under normal residential use, care and maintenance to the original owner-purchaser with proof of purchase from an authorized VOGT dealer. The only acceptable proof of purchase is the original dated sales receipt. This warranty extends to the original owner and is not transferable to a subsequent owner of the residence where products are installed.

Subject to the Warranty Service provision below, if the original owner reports the product to **VOGT** or authorized **VOGT** dealer, within the warranty period, as being defective, **VOGT** will provide replacement parts free of charge or will replace the product (with a product of equal value) at the location of the purchase at the option of **VOGT**. **VOGT** reserves the right to inspect the product reported to be defective prior to any action.
